Speakers

Dr. Jason Martin, an Associate Librarian at the University of Central Florida Libraries, was formerly the Patents and Trademark Librarian at Louisiana State University and the University of Central Florida. The UCF Patent and Trademark Depository Library (PTDL) is open to the public. He will explain the benefits of using the PTDL, its hours, and how to find parking. He will also demystify patent classification codes and how they are used in patent searching.

Dr. M.J. Soileau Ph.D., UCF VP for Research and Commercialization, will be talking on how UCF handles commercialization of UCF inventions. Dr. Soileau is well qualified in the area of innovation. With a M.S. in Physics/Optics, and Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering/Quantum Electronics he is on the board of over a dozen profit and non-profit companies. He has served in the Air Force, Navy, and as a professor at two universities and has been at UCF since 1987.

Jim Bowie, The Site Manager of the UCF Business Incubator in St. Cloud, will tell you how UCF can help you build your business.

Paul Royal BSME, J.D., a Registered Patent Agent and former Patent Examiner, will talk about how to write patent claims.
